Also stated, “The Sisters area has been designated as a severely distressed community and this event give us the opportunity for the community to support our children and families.”

\$100 per school year allows FAN to connect a child to basic-need services. Through the efforts of the Spa at Black Butte Ranch and Shibui Spa many deserving families will be protected through 2010.

Black Butte Ranch is a family destination in Central Oregon eight miles west of Sisters, Oregon offering lodging, vacation rentals and numerous winter and summer recreation activities including spa, skiing, snowshoeing, golf, tennis, biking, swimming, fishing, horse rides, running and other recreational pursuits.

The “*Green*” built FivePine Lodge provides the ultimate getaway; and was voted Bend Living’s “Best Place for Romance in Central Oregon”. The craftsman style cabins provide privacy and serenity. FAN began in January 1993 and currently employs 22 advocates in 43 public schools (K-12) and two early childhood sites. FAN strives to improve lives by ensuring all children in Deschutes County have access to basic-need services. FAN is unique to Deschutes County, utilizing advocates to efficiently reach and connect disadvantaged children and families with basic needs, such as food, shelter, and health care. During the 2008/2009 school year FAN connected over 7,800 children and their family members with food, shelter, health care and other critical services.
