BLACK BUTTE RANCH FACT SHEET

- Location:** Black Butte Ranch, Oregon is a 1,800-acre destination family resort community located seven miles west of Sisters on Highway 20 in the Central Oregon Cascades.
- Getting Here:** The Redmond Municipal Airport/Roberts Field (RDM) is 30 minutes away from Black Butte Ranch. It is served by four air carriers: Allegiant, Delta, Alaska/Horizon and United Express. The airport features daily direct flights to and from Denver, Portland, San Francisco, Salt Lake City and Seattle. Flights to Oakland and Phoenix/Mesa (seasonal) operate twice weekly.
- General Description:** Black Butte Ranch is designed for an authentic Central Oregon cascade experience. The destination community sits in between the Cascade Mountain range with sweeping views of Three Sisters, Mount Washington, Black Butte, Broken Top, Three Fingered Jack and Mount Jefferson.
- At the northern tip of the Ranch is Big Meadow, which is home to horses and cattle and the origins upon which the Ranch was founded. Further south lays dense ponderosa and aspen tree forests which affords privacy for the community, as well as a natural setting characterized by a close relationship to nature.
- The abundant wildlife is a prominent feature on the Ranch. Native deer, osprey, hawks, falcons, and migratory birds such as geese, hummingbirds and bluebirds are all visible at the Ranch through the four seasons.
- Distinguishing Black Butte Ranch is its adherence to the Ranch history, character, environment and history of the surrounding area, all of which have been crafted into the design and ambiance of the destination resort community.

- Welcome Center:** The spacious Black Butte Ranch Welcome Center is open daily and situated at the entry to the Ranch. The facility includes guest registration, gate access, information guides for guests of the Ranch.
- Vacation Rentals:** Ranging from private hotel-style lodge rooms to luxurious six-bedroom residences, Black Butte Ranch offers over 120 privately-owned, professionally managed vacation rentals consisting of cabins, condominiums and custom homes for overnight guests. Twenty of the homes are pet-friendly. Depending on the season and selected accommodations, nightly rates range from \$90 to \$965. Reservations: 866.901.2961
- Big Meadow Course:** Black Butte Ranch's 18-hole, par 72 Robert Muir Graves-designed course provides a classic mountain golf experience. With lurking water hazards and gentle elevation changes, Big Meadow requires precise shot making combined with an imaginative short game. This popular Central Oregon layout has played host to numerous Oregon golf championships since its debut more than 40 years ago. Reservations: 541.595.1500
- Glaze Meadow Course:** Glaze Meadow Golf Course, re-opened in May after a \$3.75 million renovation carried out by architect John Fought, is nestled among the rolling foothills of the Cascade Mountain range. The 18-hole, 7,007-yard course winds through Quaking Aspen groves and home sites of Black Butte Ranch. The views of 6,436-foot Black Butte, once visited by Lewis and Clark, remind visitors of the history and diversity of the area. The renovation has introduced "Classic Golf" era feel with elevated greens, sunken chipping areas and deep grass-faced bunkers, reminiscent of the legendary designs of Donald Ross or Harry Colt.
- Recreation:** There is no end to the recreation possibilities at Black Butte Ranch. In addition to two championship golf courses, the Ranch features 18 miles of paved walking and biking paths, five outdoor swimming pools, award-winning restaurants, full service day spa, fitness center, horseback riding, tennis and abundant year-round recreation opportunities including fishing, rafting, snowshoeing, cross country skiing and more.
