Note that sections of the Met-Win, Peterson Burn, and other trails to the west and south were damaged or impacted by the 2017 Mill Fire and the 2012 Pole Creek Fire.

CAUTION: 880 is a primitive road. Not recommended for big rigs, horse trailers or low-clearance vehicles.

Parking for the Green Ridge trail is available at the trail crossing on FS 1120 / Allingham Canyon Rd. The trail heads north for approx. 1.2 miles to a junction at Star road. FS 1450/900 is short distance from the intersection of FS 1450 & FS 1140.
