

Black Butte Ranch – now more than ever





Black Butte Ranch's 36 holes of golf are a main attraction, of course. Fought returned to Black Butte Ranch in 2020 to design Little Meadow — Black Butte Ranch's 12hole putting course that can be configured into 18 shorter holes. Since its opening, the putting course set near Big Meadow has been a hit with families and friends — no matter the skill level, no matter the age.
