2022 21st Annual Central Oregon Shoot-Out 2 Person Team Championship 3 Great Days – 3 Great Courses

Scramble Format - Friday, April 22nd

1st & 2nd Net – The Eagle Crest Ridge Course 3rd & 4th Net- Aspen Lakes

5th & 6th Net – Glaze Meadow at Black Butte Ranch (Gate Code 11258 #)

On each hole, both partners drive and the best drive is selected. Each partner plays a second shot from within a club length through the green or six inches on the green of the spot for the selected drive. The best second shot is selected. This process is repeated until the hole is completed. Shots selected through the green, in a hazard, or on the green must remain in the same defined area. Each player must play 6 tee shots.

Team Handicap – 70% of team average handicap

Best Ball Format - Saturday, April 23rd

1st & 2nd Net – Glaze Meadow at Black Butte Ranch (Gate Code 11258 #)

3rd & 4th Net- The Eagle Crest Ridge Course

 5^{th} & 6^{th} Net – Aspen Lakes

Both partners play their own ball until holed. The best net score is used as the team score taking the strokes where they fall on the scorecard.

Team Handicap - 80% of individual handicap

Chapman Format - Sunday, April 24th

 I^{st} & 2^{nd} Net – Aspen Lakes

3rd & 4th Net – Glaze Meadow at Black Butte Ranch (Gate Code 11258 #)

5th & 6th Net – The Eagle Crest Ridge Course

Both partners drive from each tee, and then each player plays a second shot with the other's ball. After the second shots, a choice is made regarding the ball with which the hole will be completed, alternate shots being continued until the ball is holed.

Team Handicap – 90% of team *average* handicap.

Team Handicap broken into quarters

Electronic devices are legal if they are within the USGA rules and regulations for 2019. Electronic devices that measure slope/elevation are prohibited.

Snow is casual water [25-1] \$20.00 per team Honey Pot optional each day!

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. Ball must be placed back in original position. Modified using Rule (18-2, 18-3, 20-1) Burrowing animal holes, casts or runways are abnormal ground conditions, and <u>rule 16.1, Model local rule F-6</u> tells us when interference from an abnormal ground condition exists: This will be used for Ball only, (Not stance).
