BLACK BUTTE RANCH HAS LONG BEEN CENTRAL OREGON'S IDEAL PLACE TO COME TOGETHER

(BLACK BUTTE RANCH, Ore.) — Since 1970, Black Butte Ranch has offered a unique, family-oriented Central Oregon experience at the foot of the gorgeous Cascade Range. The sweeping 1,800-acre destination resort features sweeping views of the surrounding peaks — including Three Sisters, Mount Washington, Black Butte, Broken Top, Three Fingered Jack and Mount Jefferson — and endless outdoor opportunities.

A former working ranch, Black Butte Ranch was designed to celebrate the history, character, and environment of the region. With each aspect painstakingly integrated into the design and ambiance of the destination resort community.

The northern section of Black Back Butte Ranch is set in Big Meadow, the focal point of the resort. This is home to the Welcome Center, Lodge, Lakeside Activity Center and Big Meadow golf course, as well as horses and cattle indicative of the resort's ranching past. A dense forest of ponderosa pines and aspens at the southern end of the resort, where Glaze Meadow and other amenities sit, afford privacy for the community in a natural setting.

Throughout Black Butte Ranch, wildlife is abundant. Native deer, osprey, hawks, falcons, and migratory birds, including geese, hummingbirds, and bluebirds, are frequent sights and show off the resort's close relationship to nature.

Location:

Located 7 miles west of Sisters along U.S. Highway 20, Black Butte Ranch is a family-oriented destination resort spread over 1,800 -acres at the foot of the Central Oregon Cascade Range.

Getting Here:

Black Butte Ranch is 30 minutes from Redmond Municipal Airport/Roberts Field. RDM is serviced by seven air carriers offering daily nonstop flights to and from Denver, Los Angeles, Phoenix, Salt Lake City, San Diego, San

Francisco, and Seattle, as well twice weekly and/or seasonal routes to Burbank, Las Vegas, and Reno. By car, Black Butte Ranch is 30 miles west of Bend, 100 miles east of Eugene, and 150 miles southeast of Portland.

Welcome Center:

The spacious Black Butte Ranch Welcome Center is open daily and situated at the entrance off U.S. Highway 20. The facility includes guest registration, gate access, and information guides for Ranch guests.

Vacation Rentals:

Ranging from private hotel-style lodge rooms to luxurious six-bedroom residences, Black Butte Ranch offers more than 120 privately owned, professionally managed vacation rentals consisting of cabins, condominiums and custom homes for overnight guests. Big Meadow Course:

Opened in 1972 and renovated in 2008, the Robert Muir Graves design helped make Central Oregon a golf destination. The 7,002-yard, par-72 championship course winds through ponderosa pines and aspen groves and is highlighted by incredible views of the Cascade Ranch. Big Meadow's generous fairways are forgiving enough to be friendly to novices. But the course's bunkering, greens, and gentle elevation changes require precision shotmaking, offering enough challenge to host some of the Pacific Northwest's most prestigious golf tournaments. Glaze Meadow Course:

Originally designed by legendary Northwest golf pro Gene "Bunny" Mason in 1908, Glaze Meadow took on new character with John Fought's \$3.75 million renovation in 2012. Shaped from the rolling foothills of the Cascade Range, the 7,007--yard, par 72 redesign is an homage to the "Golden Era" of golf design of the 1920s and 30s. The course winds through aspen groves and ponderosas, but is brought to life with its turtleback greens, sunken chipping areas and deep grass-faced bunkers, reminiscent of the legendary designs of Donald Ross or Harry Colt. Little Meadow Putting Course:

10 years after renovating Glaze Meadow, John Fought returned to design Little Meadow. Set near the clubhouse of Big Meadow, this 12-hole putting course is beloved by families and friends, experts and novices, and the young and old. The main holes range in length from 45 to 105 feet, with lush fairways, challenging undulations, rock formations, and natural landscaping. But the design can be stretched to 18 shorter holes or played as nine longer holes, with ample opportunity to move tees and hole locations, and reverse holes, to provide a new experience each day. Recreation:

In addition to two championship golf courses and putting course, Black Butte Ranch features 18 miles of paved walking and biking paths, five outdoor swimming pools, award-winning restaurants, a full-service day spa, state-of-the-art fitness and activity center, horseback riding, and tennis. In addition, Black Butte Ranch is

ideally situated to take full advantage of Central Oregon's abundant year-round outdoor opportunities including biking, fishing, rafting, skiing, snowboarding, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, and more.

Dining:

Black Butte Ranch is home to two distinct farm-to table dining options in Robert's Pub and The Lodge Restaurant, which will reopen in 2023 with the new Lodge. Both have been recognized as top restaurants in Central Oregon by Urbanspoon and The (Bend) Bulletin. The Lakeside Bistro offers casual dining in a gorgeous and fun setting. The Aspen Lounge, the General Store, and Glaze Meadow Snack Shop are great places for snacks, sandwiches, and small bites. Dean Ecker has served as Black Butte Ranch's Food and Beverage Director since 2006.

The Spa at Black Butte Ranch offers a diverse range of spa treatments that provide the utmost in relaxation and rejuvenation, along with the latest developments in skin care and other active lifestyle spa services.
