**LITTLE MEADOW PUTTING COURSE HAS BECOME ONE OF BLACK BUTTE RANCH'S MOST BELOVED FAMILY-FRIENDLY AMENITIES SINCE OPENING IN 2020**

(BLACK BUTTE RANCH, Ore.)—The smiles are apparent. The laughter is pervasive. The Little Meadow Putting Course has unquestionably become one of Black Butte Ranch's favorite amenities since the 12-hole course opened in 2020.

Watch the action at Little Meadow from on the patio of nearby Robert's Pub, enjoying a cold beer on just about any sunny day, and the joy the course brings becomes obvious. Not just among families, some with as many three generations represented in their group, but also friends. Some elite players. Some who have barely ever touched a club. And just about everyone in between.

Set near Big Meadow, Little Meadow was designed by nationally renowned architect John Fought. For Fought, who is the brother of longtime Black Butte Ranch director of golf Jeff Fought, the project was a return to Black Butte Ranch after his lauded redesign of Glaze Meadow in 2012.

Little Meadow was shaped with a similar attention to detail. The putting course makes a striking first impression. In fact, the sloping, undulating putting course looks as if it was always meant to be there. And that's just what Fought was going for when he designed Little Meadow.

Each hole's contours test even the best putters, and every hole's "fairway" is kept to the exacting and high standards of the putting surfaces found on Big Meadow and Glaze Meadow.

Fought incorporated rock formations into his design and accentuated the putting course with native landscape. The appearance is eye-catching.

But Fought designed the 12-hole course with both form and function in main. The main setup features 12 holes of between 45 and 105 feet in length. But this alone does not tell the story. Little Meadow can be expanded to be played as 18 shorter holes. It can also be played as nine longer holes. And each of the 12 holes were designed so that they can be played in reverse.

That flexibility ensures a new experience each and every time one plays it.

In a sense, Little Meadow has become the perfect amenity for Black Butte Ranch. One that speaks to exactly what Black Butte Ranch has always been. Fun for families. Fun for friends. A place for everyone to enjoy.

It's a Central Oregon golf experience like none other.
