- Lakeside Activities Center: Outdoor pool, hot tub, sauna, poolside food and beverage service (summer only), state-of-the-art fitness center, the Spa at Black Butte Ranch, recreation center, equipment rentals, children's playground, as well as the Lakeside Bistro and General Store.
- **Glaze Meadow Recreation Center:** Indoor and outdoor pools, hot tub, wading pool, spray ground, sauna, workout facilities, sports shop, snack shop, and equipment rental shop.

### **Dining**

- The Lodge Restaurant & Aspen Lounge: Scheduled to reopen in 2023 with the unveiling of Black Butte Ranch's renovated Main Lodge, The Lodge Restaurant offers a unique lakeside fine-dining experience with incredible mountain views. The Aspen Lounge is a more casual experience, ideal to enjoy a small plate and adult beverage while enjoying a game in a gorgeous setting.
- **Robert's Place:** Set just off the 18th green of Big Meadow, Robert's Place offers Northwest-style pub fare in a friendly and casual atmosphere. Outdoor patio dining available and menu includes an extensive selection of Oregon beers and Northwest wines.
- Lakeside Bistro: Set in a modern space with expansive floor-to-ceiling windows showing off incredible Cascade views, the Bistro serves fresh, casual cuisine all day. Enjoy a fresh-brewed cup of coffee as the sun rises or toast the sunset with a cocktail, glass of wine, or Central Oregon brew from the outdoor bar. Open seasonally.
- **The General Store:** The newest addition to the Lakeside Recreation Complex, The General Store offers a wide selection of deli sandwiches, ice cream, growler refills, wine, local products and curated gifts. The General Store also serves to-go dinner boxes during the holidays.
- Glaze Meadow Snack Shop: Open seasonally at the outdoor pool at the Glaze Meadow Recreation Center, the snack bar Snack Bar offers ice cream, snacks, burgers, espresso drinks, and other cold refreshments.

# <u>Golf</u>

• **Big Meadow:** Designed by legendary architect Robert Muir Graves in 1972, the 7,002-yard Big Meadow is Black Butte Ranch's original 18-hole, par-72 championship course. **Summer rates:** \$58-\$72 for 18 holes; \$38-\$46 for nine holes.

- **Glaze Meadow:** Renovated in 2012 by renowned architect John Fought, Glaze Meadow is a 7,007-yard, par-72 championship course. **Summer rates:** \$58-\$72 for 18 holes; \$38-\$46 for nine holes.
- Little Meadow Putting Course: Designed by John Fought and opened in 2020, this 12-hole putting course features holes ranging in length from 45 to 105 feet. Summer rates: \$12 for adults, \$8 for children ages 7-17, and free for children 6 and under.
