

DROP-IN PLAY GUIDELINES

Courts # 5 and # 6 will be for Recreational Players (3.0±) with less competitive emphasis.

Courts #8 will be for Beginners

Courts #7, #9 & #10 Intermediate (3.5 >)

Courts #11 & #12 Advanced Play (4.0 >)

Players self-select their skill level. See "Pickleball Skills Levels" (on sandwich board) for a simple way to figure out your skill level.

A paddle holder will be provided for each designated area. Each court has a paddle rack system which determines order of play. Paddles furthest to the right are next up. When game concludes, the next player(s) rotate in. This system provides all players fair access to court time when it's crowded. When a game concludes (first team to 11, win by 2) the next player(s) with their paddles furthest to the right are up.

Drop-in players have priority for courts during drop-in sessions. However, other players may use empty courts until they are needed for drop-in play.

Court reservations are available the day prior to play and the day of play. Reservations may be made by calling 541-595-1285 or stopping by the recreation counter at GMRC. Court reservations are limited to two hours of play per day per household, except in the case of the lighted tennis courts which are limited to one hour of play during the evening period after 7 pm. Reservation courts that are not in use 10 minutes after the hour become available for drop-in play until the next reservation.





Be Prepared for Emergencies

BE READY. GET SET. GO!

Know evacuation levels and follow advice of emergency officials

Level 1: BE READY

BE AWARE - DANGER IN THE AREA PREPARE TO EVACUATE

- Monitor emergency services websites and local news media
- Opt-in with Deschutes County to receive local Emergency Alerts
- Have your Emergency Plan and Go-Kit ready

Level 2: GET SET

SIGNIFICANT DANGER IN THE AREA – PREPARE TO LEAVE

- Conditions can change rapidly this may be the only notice you receive
- Time to act follow your Emergency Plan
- Relocate to a safe place and let loved ones know you are safe

Level 3: GO!

DANGER IS IMMINENT

- Leave without delay, it is unsafe to stay
- Do not gather belongings or stay to protect the home
- Emergency services may not be able to assist you

In the event of evacuation, signs will be placed on evacuation routes

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- NO FIREWORKS ALLOWED at any time
- NO Briquettes or Wood BBQs
- Extinguish Cigarettes properly and completely
- · Open Burning is prohibited

- Dogs are welcome, but they must be leashed at all times while in public spaces
- Immediate cleanup after dogs is req'd.
- Waste bags and disposal stations are conveniently located at key points throughout the Ranch.

- All photo shoots (including still, video, drones, etc.) require a permit in advance.

- Extinguish cigarettes properly
- Propane BBQs are permitted yearround. Briquette BBQs are not allowed during fire season or at vacation rentals
- Fireworks are not allowed (even sparklers)
- Open burning is prohibited.

Discharging of firearms is prohibited.





- BBR issued Access
 Pass must be
 displayed at all times.
- No parking on roads or shoulders (Unless authorized for events)
- Overnight parking of RVs, motorhomes, or trailers in any BBR lot. (Parking is allowed on owner lots for up to 48 hours)



- All bikes, walkers, joggers, personal mobility devices are to use the bike path, not the road (Unless a bike path is unavailable).
- Foot traffic only on nature trails.
- Helmets req'd for everyone under
 16 years old for bikes, razers and rollerblades. They are recommended for everyone!
- E-bikes must be registered at the GM Rental Shop. Helmets req'd. Limit 15MPH



 Motorcycles, ATV's and UTV's are prohibited behind the gates. (Except BBR Maintenance vehicles)



- No swimming or wading in lakes or streams
- No fishing in lakes or streams (Except catch & release fly fishing on Phalarope Lake with valid license)
