- Adults only until 10am
- Kids 6 years and younger are NOT allowed in hot tub or sauna
- Kids 7 years and older must be SUPERVISED by an adult
- No toys or playing in hot tub
- Bring your own towels
- No glass or alcohol allowed.
- Kids under 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult
- If No Lifeguards on Duty - Obey all posted rules and supervise your children

SLIDE RULES

- Parents or a responsible adult supervisor must supervise their children while using the slide & ensure that all posted rules are followed
- One person at a time on the stairs & slide
- Slide feet first only
- Slide one person at a time only
- Allow the previous user to clear the landing area before using slide
- No climbing UP the slide
- No tubes/floats allowed on the slide
- Do not somersault, twist, or dive
- Do not jump off the top of the slide
- Children ages 3-5 must have an adult with them
- Children under the age of 3 are not allowed

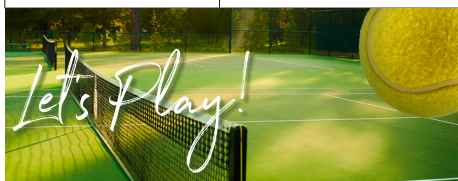

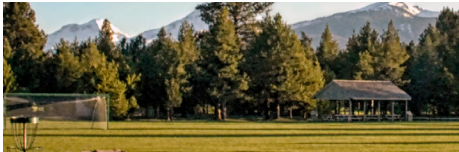

THERE IS A PLACE

Be Prepared for Emergencies

BE READY. GET SET. GO!

Know evacuation levels and follow advice of emergency officials

Level 1 BE READY

BE AWARE - DANGER IN THE AREA - PREPARE TO EVACUATE

- Monitor emergency services websites and local news
- Opt-in to receive local Emergency Alerts*
- Have your Emergency Plan and Go-Kit ready

Level 2 GET SET

SIGNIFICANT DANGER IN THE AREA - PREPARE TO LEAVE

- Conditions change rapidly-this may be the only notice you receive
- Time to act-follow your Emergency Plan
- Relocate to a safe place and let loved ones know you are safe

Level 3 GO!

DANGER IS IMMINENT - GO NOW

- Leave without delay, it is unsafe to stay
- Do not gather belongings or make efforts to protect the home
- Emergency services may not be able to assist if you stay

In the event of evacuation, BBR Police will place signs on evacuation routes

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- NO FIREWORKS ALLOWED at any time
- NO Briquettes or Wood BBQs
- Extinguish Cigarettes properly and completely
- Open Burning is prohibited

Rules of the Road

25

SPEED LIMIT:

The maximum speed limit is **25 MPH** for cars
15 MPH for bicycles



BIKE PATH ALLOWED DEVICES:

- ♦ All bicycles
- ♦ Class 1 E-bikes (two-wheeled, pedal-assist only, low-speed electric bicycles, with no throttle, that have a maximum assisted speed of 20 mph)
- ♦ Non-electric scooters
- ♦ Tricycles
- ♦ Walkers
- ♦ Joggers
- ♦ ADA personal mobility devices are **OK** to use on bike paths, not the road (unless a bike path is unavailable)

PARKING:

NO STREET PARKING:
All vehicles must be parked off the road.

- ♦ **Home Parking:**
Every home must provide at least two designated parking spaces.
- ♦ **Large Vehicles & Trailers:**
Class A and C motorhomes, boats, and trailers are prohibited in common parking lots. All RVs, boats, and inoperable vehicles must be stored within a fully enclosed garage or the official maintenance yard storage compound.
- ♦ **Camper Vans:**
Class B vans are okay in designated spots only if they are your main ride and you aren't sleeping in them.
- ♦ **Construction Gear:**
Must be removed immediately once the job is completed.



PROHIBITED DEVICES:

- ♦ Skateboards
- ♦ Longboards
- ♦ Hoverboards
- ♦ Roller skates
- ♦ Inline skates
- ♦ One and two wheeled electric balancing devices and electric scooter devices are not permitted.

PROHIBITED BEHIND THE GATES:

- ♦ Motorcycles
- ♦ ATVs,
- ♦ UTVs
- ♦ Class 2 and Class 3 E-Bikes (throttled-assisted or pedal-assisted E-bikes capable of higher than 20mph)
- ♦ Mo-Peds (Except BBR Maintenance vehicles)



HELMETS:

Helmets required for everyone under 16 years old for bikes, and scooters. They are recommended for everyone!



TRAILS:

Foot traffic only on nature trails.



ACCESS REGISTRATION:

BBR issued Access Pass must be displayed at all times.

Rules & Regulations



FIRE SAFETY:

- ♦ Extinguish cigarettes properly.
- ♦ Only pellet and LPG (propane) BBQ's, grills, and smokers allowed.
- ♦ NO wood fires.
- ♦ Charcoal/Briquette BBQs are NOT allowed during fire season or at any home.
- ♦ Fireworks are prohibited (including sparklers).
- ♦ No seasonal open burning.



OTHER RESTRICTIONS:

- ♦ No loud, disturbing or unnecessary noise.
- ♦ No Marijuana use in a public place or rental homes.



PHOTOGRAPHY:

- ♦ A permit is required in advance for all photo shoots (still photography, video, etc.).
- ♦ Drone photography is prohibited.

EMERGENCIES:

- ♦ BBR Fire Department has 24/7 paramedic staffing and a fully-equipped first aid room.
- ♦ Medical helicopters utilize the Sports Field.

DOGS:

- ♦ Keep dogs leashed in public.
- ♦ Clean up waste immediately.
- ♦ Disposal bags are provided at stations across the Ranch.



LAKE & STREAMS:

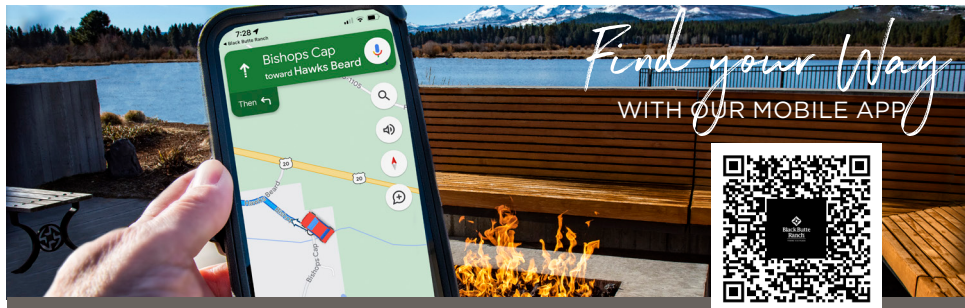
- ♦ No swimming or wading in lakes or streams.
- ♦ No fishing allowed. (except for licensed, catch-and-release fly fishing on Phalarope Lake).
- ♦ No flotation devices permitted (except on Phalarope Lake).



WILDLIFE & PET SAFETY:

- ♦ Respect Wildlife: Keep your distance and leave them alone.
- ♦ Keep kids and pets close and in sight.
- ♦ Avoid letting pets out alone at night. Always check the yard first.
- ♦ Make noise (talk, clap, sing) to avoid surprising animals.
- ♦ Stay aware: Look for tracks, scat, and other signs of wildlife.
- ♦ Secure food: Keep decks, garbage, and BBQs clean. Bring pet food/water bowls inside.
- ♦ Report sightings to Police Dept: (541-595-2191)
